

Marion Township Continued Budget Meeting Held October 14, 2019 at the Township Building

Present: Archie Gettig, Jr., John (Rick) Dillon, Herb Chapman and Angel Emery
Guests: None

Chairman Gettig called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Discussion was held about projects being done within the township. The estimate for the Sand Ridge and Weights Lane pipe replacement projects was reviewed, currently half (\$20,000) the amount of the project, was received from Centre County Liquid Fuels in the form of a grant.

There is currently \$56,126.09 in Marion Township's state liquid fuels account with an estimated \$36,887.70 to be received in 2020. There is \$36,379.40 in the state equipment fund with an estimated \$9,221.93 being received in 2020.

The building at the park that will be used as a substation for Howard Fire Company was discussed as well as the possibility of paving from Weight's Lane in to the park. Gettig will get prices. Dillon would like to see a sign on the building that says "Substation", Howard Fire Company has discussed doing that. The board will reach out to Howard Fire Company to present the idea of the fire tax going in to the work that is being done at the substation rather than going to the fire company.

Dillon mentioned keeping the budget pretty much the same as 2019 with the exception of the park which he would like to increase by \$1,000.

Dillon requested Emery contact Louis Glantz to see if he would be available to attend all the BOS meetings in 2020 and what the cost would be.

Dillon would like to start a new line item for the truck purchase to put money back so that the township is prepared for the payments.

Emery will make changes to budget and present at the November BOS meeting.
