# **Emergency Drills Procedures**

### Fire Drill

### From Classrooms:

- 1. Post a **fire drill exit sign** prominently in your classroom.
- 2. Move the **students single file**, quietly and quickly to exits when fire signal sounds.

K-2 are to use the west exit (door # 3 behind the kitchen)

- 3-6 are to use the south exit (door #2) Once outside, move the students to the **far** side of the parking lot.
- 3. **Take attendance** to account for all students.
- 4. Use an **alternate exit** if assigned exit is blocked.

# From Church

- 1. Become silent and **listen for verbal instructions** from an authorized staff member\*.
- 2. Students are to stay with their teacher or authorized staff member\* at all times.
- 3. The **closest safe exits** to the outside will be used if possible.

**Church**, the **vestibule doors** will be used to exit to the front parking lot.

Gym – the rear doors to the parking lot (doors #6 & #7) will be used. Move to the ball field backstop area.

# From Playground:

- 1. Become silent and listen for instructions.
- 2. Stay with the playground monitor.
- 3. Move away from the school building to the ball field backstop.

### Tornado Drill

If a tornado warning is announced and there is adequate time, we will move all students and staff to the **Rectory basement.** 

If little advance notice is given, we will follow these procedures:

- Kindergarten go to the conference room and sit under the table
- Kindergarten, Grades 1, and 2 Go to the Girls' Restroom
- Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 Go to the Boys Restroom

### **From Classrooms:**

- 1. Post a **tornado drill sign** prominently in your classroom.
- **2.** When at tornado warning is announced:
  - Instruct students to take a **heavy book** to cover their heads.
  - Move students **single file**, quietly and quickly.
  - All students should remain with the classroom teacher.
- **3.** Take attendance to account for all students.
- 4. When signaled:
  - students should get down in a sitting position,
  - knees drawn up; heads to their knees and hold books over their heads.
  - **Remain quiet** during the drill.
- 5. An authorized staff member will dismiss you after the threat or drill is completed.

### From Gym or Church:

- 1. Follow instructions from an authorized staff member\* to move quickly and quietly to the designated shelter areas.
- **2.** Follow instructions above with the exception of taking a heavy book.

# From Play Ground

- 1. Follow instructions from an authorized staff member\* to move quickly and quietly into the school and to the designated shelter areas.
- **2.** Follow instructions above with the exception of taking a heavy book.

# **Lock Down Procedure**

A Lock Down will be initiated by the words "Lock Down" over the P.A. system or audibly by an authorized staff member\* if:

- any suspicious activity takes place or
- a suspicious person enters the premises.

### In Classroom:

- 1. Lock down announcement
- 2. Turn lights off!
- **3.** Door closed (should already by locked)
- **4.** Tape a paper to window visible from outside with number of students and adults in the room
- 5. Window blinds closed (all windows including doors)
- **6.** Go to predetermined hiding place in the room
- 7. Remain silent at all times
- **8.** Remain in hiding until the door is unlocked by an authorized staff member\*, police officer or firefighter. Listen for instructions for exiting the building.

# In Gym:

- 1. Become silent to listen to instruction from authorized staff member\*. Move to designated area.
  - Grades K-2 Gym teacher's office (by gym exit door #6)
  - Grades 3-5 Maintenance office (door off of gym)
- 2. Remain silent at all times.
- 3. Remain in hiding area until the door is unlocked by an authorized staff member\*.
- 4. Follow instructions for exiting the building.

**In Church:** Hide under pews and be silent.

**On Playground:** Follow Rapid Evacuation instructions below.

# **Rapid Evacuation Drill**

Rapid Dismissal Drills are practiced in the event the building becomes unsafe for the students. Students, escorted by staff members, will **leave the premises** by crossing the grassy area behind the school and proceeding to Rosalie Drive.

In a safe manner an authorized staff member\*, law enforcement agent and/or fire department personnel will direct the students to the former *Christian Life Center* at the corner of Ervin Road and Route 116.

In the event of an actual rapid evacuation, parents/guardians will meet their child/children at this location. Children will be dismissed to ONLY the parents/guardians or officially designated custodian.
