- **VPK HOMEWORK**- Our VPK students will be receiving weekly homework from their class. On Fridays the homework will be in their mailbox ready for you to take and do over the weekend. Please bring the homework back to school on Tuesday.

MONTHLY EVENTS:

- **MAIL DAY MONDAYS**: Every other Monday is mail day. On this day, you can bring us a letter from you to your child and the "mailman" will have it delivered to their classrooms. Your child's teacher will read them his/her letter during a special "love filled circle time". You can also have your child write letters to some of their favorite friends!
- **WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY**: Every Wednesday each class has Bible Study for approximately 15-20 minutes to teach the children a mini lesson from the bible. The children get very excited and love the stories.
- **SPIRIT SHIRT FRIDAYS**- Every Friday is spirit day. Wear your BFF Kidz shirt to show some pride!
- **VPK CLUBS**- We will be hosting a Letters and Keepsakes club (2nd Tuesday of every month), Garden & Workshop Club (3rd Tuesday of every month), and a Music and Bible Club (3rd Tuesday of every month) for our VPK students. If you are interested in signing your child up for any of these clubs, see signup in front office.
- **Reading is FUNDamental**. We ask all families to make sure they are reading to their children nightly. If your child has a favorite book that they would like to bring in from home for the teacher to read in class, please feel free to bring it in and the teacher will read it to the class.
- **Scholastic Books** – Purchase low price books monthly through scholastic, ordering forms in your mailbox and can purchase online or with paper form, please have order turned in by the 3rd Thursday of the month.
- **PARKING LOT SAFETY**: We all are very busy and, in a hurry, to get to places on time. Although we may be in a hurry, it is important to follow all the signs in the parking lot to ensure every child and parent enters and exits safely. Please enter ONLY through the entrance and exit ONLY through the exit to avoid any potential accidents. Also please do not park in the underpass unless it is raining as this may cause traffic and confusion during drop-offs and pick-ups. Our goal is to ensure the safety of all students and members on our property. If you have any questions or concerns, please speak with a member of the admin staff.
- **REVIEWING POLICIES**:
 - **PAYMENTS**: Tuition is due on the Friday before the upcoming week the children will be attending.
 - **LATE PAYMENTS**: Any accounts with a balance on Friday at 5pm will be subject to our late payment fee of \$15, as stated on the Parent Handbook.
 - **VACATION**: If your child will be on vacation for an entire week, please let us know in advance, and we will charge a \$40 spot hold fee in place of your Tuition Rate as a courtesy.
 - **WITHDRAWAL**: A two-week written notice is required for all children enrolled in a full-time, part-time, Preschool, or VPK only program. Please note that if you chose to leave without giving us the 2 weeks' notice you will still be in charge of paying the tuition for those 2 weeks.Parent handbook can always be found online at our website.
