### **“Up North Seasons”**

Four wall hangings to choose from – Winter, Spring, Summer & Autumn.

## **Description of class**

Make any one of these 18” x 18” wall hangings in a one day class, using the patterns, “Up North Winter”, “Up North Spring”, “Up North Summer” OR “Up North Autumn” by Sue Pritt.

Techniques of simple piecing, fusible web machine appliqué and quilting as you go.

## **Skill Level**

Beginner to advanced.

## **Number of Students**

8 to 10

## **Supply List for “Up North Winter”**

Batting & Backing 21” x 21” EACH

Dark Blue (inside border) – 9” x 21” (fat eighth)

Dark Blue Print (outside border & binding) – 18” x 21” (fat quarter)

Sky Blue – 12-1/2” x 12-1/2”

Medium Dark Blue (mountains) 10” x 4”

Pine Tree Green (pines) 7”square

Medium Green (boughs) 12” square

White (snow & coat trim) 11” square

Red (cardinals) 6”square

Red Plaid (coats) 5”square

Black(birds) 3” square

Orange (beaks) 2” square

3 sheets light paper backed fusible web (Print-N-Fuse OR lite Heat & Bond)

Sewing machine with piecing foot, walking foot & free motion foot.

Usual sewing supplies

## **Jump Start Directions for “Up North Winter” . . . .**

For homework, you may follow step one on page 1 and cut the items listed there.

Be sure to place them in one large baggie to bring to class.

ALSO, If you have done fusible web appliqué before, you may trace & label (or photograph the shapes on pages 2, 3 & 4 onto the paper side of three fusible web sheets.

Cut the sheets apart on the dashed lines and fuse the entire sections to the WRONG side of your fabrics. Cut out shapes (pieces). Place all “C” pieces in one small baggie and remaining pieces in one large baggie.

Green Print (outside border & binding) - 1 FO (18"x 21")  
Sky Blue (background) - 12-1/2" square  
Medium Dark Blue (mountains) - 10" x 3"  
Pine Green (pine trees) - 7" x 3"  
Brown (branches, roof & perch) - 11" x 6"  
Pink (flowers) - 9" square  
Medium Green (leaves) - 4" square  
Yellow (Goldfinches & Bee) - 5" square  
Black (birds & bee) - 5" square  
Red (birdhouse) - 5" square  
Red Plaid (birdhouse) - 5" square  
White (house & birds & bee) - 8" x 4"  
Orange (beaks & feet) - 2" square  
3 sheets paper backed fusible web (Print-N-Fuse OR Lite Heat & Bond)  
Sewing machine with piecing foot, walking foot & free motion foot.

For homework, you may follow step one on page 1 and cut the items listed there.

Be sure to place them in one large baggie to bring to class.

ALSO, If you have done fusible web appliqué before, you may trace & label (or photograph the shapes on pages 2, 3 & 4 onto the paper side of three fusible web sheets. Cut the sheets apart on the dashed lines and fuse the entire sections to the **WRONG** side of your fabrics. Cut out shapes (pieces). Place all "G" pieces in one small baggie – all "H" pieces in another small baggie AND remaining pieces in one large baggie.

Batting & Backing 21" x 21" EACH  
Grey (inside border & appliqué) - 1 FE (9" x 21")  
Black Print (outside border & binding) - 1 FO (18"x 21")  
"Lake Water" Blue (background) - 12-1/2"w x 10"h  
Medium Green (background & leaves) - 12" square  
Pine Green (pine trees & lily pads) - 8" square  
Brown (cattails) - 3" square  
White (loons & water lily) - 4" square  
White with Black (bonnet) - 6" square  
Black (loons) - 6" square  
Black with White (Momma loon body) - 8" x 4"  
Red (Momma loon eye) - 1" square  
Pink (baby girl loon bow) - 1" square  
Yellow (center of water lily) - 1" square

3 sheets paper-backed fusible web (Print-N-Fuse OR Lite Heat & Bond)  
Sewing machine with piecing foot, walking foot & free motion foot.

For homework, you may follow step one on page 1 and cut the items listed there.

Be sure to place them in one large baggie to bring to class.

ALSO, If you have done fusible web appliqué before, you may trace & label (or photograph the shapes on pages 2& 3 onto the paper side of three fusible web sheets. Cut the sheets apart on the dashed lines and fuse the entire sections to the **WRONG** side of your fabrics. Cut out shapes (pieces). Place all “ML” pieces in one small baggie – all “DL” pieces in another small baggie **AND** remaining pieces in one large baggie.

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### Supply List for “Up North Autumn”

Batting & Backing 21” x 21” EACH

Brown (inside border, dock, stems, cattails) -1 FE (9” x 21”)

Brown/Tan print (outside border & binding) - 1 FQ (18”x 21”)

“Lake Water” Blue (background) - 12-1/2”w x 10”h

Medium Green (background, cattail leaves, quilt) - 12” square

Pine Green (background & pine trees) - 9” square

Grey (dock & chickadees) - 11” x 4”

White (chickadees) - 4” square

Black (chickadees) - 4” square

Red (quilt, hat) - 3” square

Red Plaid (coat, hat, scarf) - 4” square

Tan (chair, rocks, cattail seeds) - 6” square

Gold/Orange (hillside, bush leaves) - 8” square

2 sheet paper-backed fusible web (Print-N-Fuse OR lite Heat & Bond)

Sewing machine with piecing foot, walking foot & free motion foot.

### Jump Start Directions for “Up North Autumn” . . . .

For homework, you may follow step one on page 1 and cut the items listed there.

Be sure to place them in one large baggie to bring to class.

ALSO, If you have done fusible web appliqué before, you may trace & label (or photograph the shapes on pages 3 & 4 onto the paper side of two fusible web sheets. Cut the sheets apart on the dashed lines and fuse the entire sections to the **WRONG** side of your fabrics. Cut out shapes (pieces). Set aside five small ziptop baggies – label them “CD”, “HS”, “LB”, “D”, & “Q”. Place all “CD” pieces in the “CD” baggie, etc, etc. Place all remaining pieces in one large baggie.
