#### **Financial Overview**

- The Authority ended the month of January with a net revenue of \$108,527, \$2,653 higher than January 2019. Total revenue was \$171,436, \$2,732 higher than January of the previous year. This increase was due to higher decal revenue of \$6,410 of which \$3,678 was offset by a decrease in metered revenue. Total expenses were \$62,909. \$79 higher than January 2019.
- The Park and Ride ended the month of January with a net revenue of \$64,862, \$17,434.97 higher than January 2019. Total revenue was \$83, 892, \$17, 551.70 higher than January of the previous year. This was mainly due to higher decal revenue of \$12,902. Metered revenue also experienced an increase of \$4,650. Total expenses were \$19,030. \$117 higher than January 2019.

#### **Unfinished Business**

• 2020 Budget: The 2020 approved budget is still at the NJDLGS. Comments were received from the NJDLGS expressing their concern about the Authority's insolvency. They are concerned about the dollar amount included in the 2018 Audit for GASB 75. This is an actuarial amount for post-retirement benefits. They recommended that the Authority consider a rate increase in 2021 and to continue eliminating expenses. Pam Piner will begin to put together a response to their concerns and outline a plan for the future.
