- 4. The **student application form** and essay answer (attached) is to be completed by applicant either typed or neatly printed in ink. If you get your application from the rioverderoverettes.org website, it must be printed off and included with all the other forms listed and postmarked by **March 30th**.
- 5. Student must submit a dated **Letter of Intent**, preferably typed, including college attending, major and/or minor, explaining future plans, goals, and financial need for this scholarship. Let us know if your family will be able to help with college, if you have savings toward college fees, if you plan to be working during school and/or summer, and approximately how many hours per week.
- 6. Applicant must submit **two (2) current dated letters** of recommendation from persons or teachers **other than relatives**, along with their **phone numbers**.
- 7. Applicant is to supply a **current photo**, suitable for publication. Photo cannot be returned.
- 8. Application must be **postmarked by March 30th.**
- 9. The scholarship shall be for any college, university or vocational school and is good only for the year issued. The scholarship will be sent out to the student upon receipt of **proof of enrollment.** This must be mailed to the treasurer, address will be provided in the acceptance letter. Exceptions shall be made for vocational schools.
