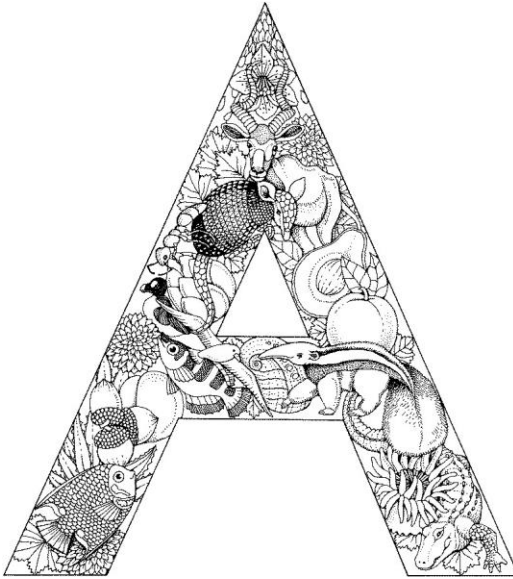

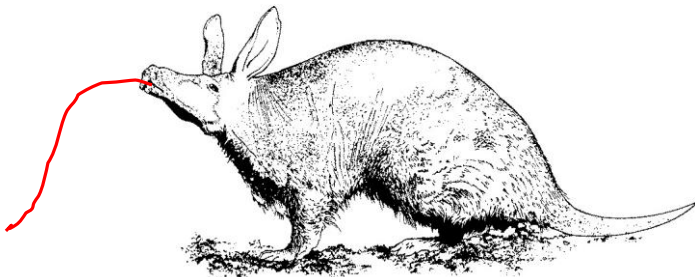

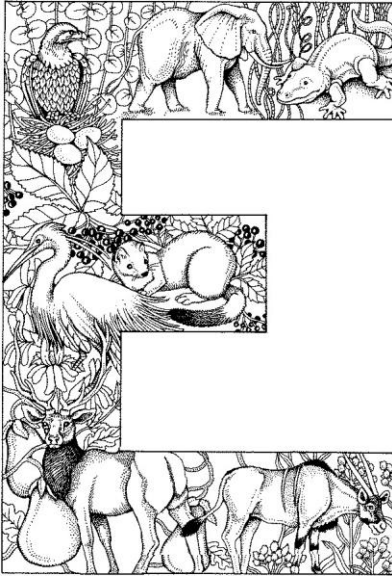

is for Aardvark

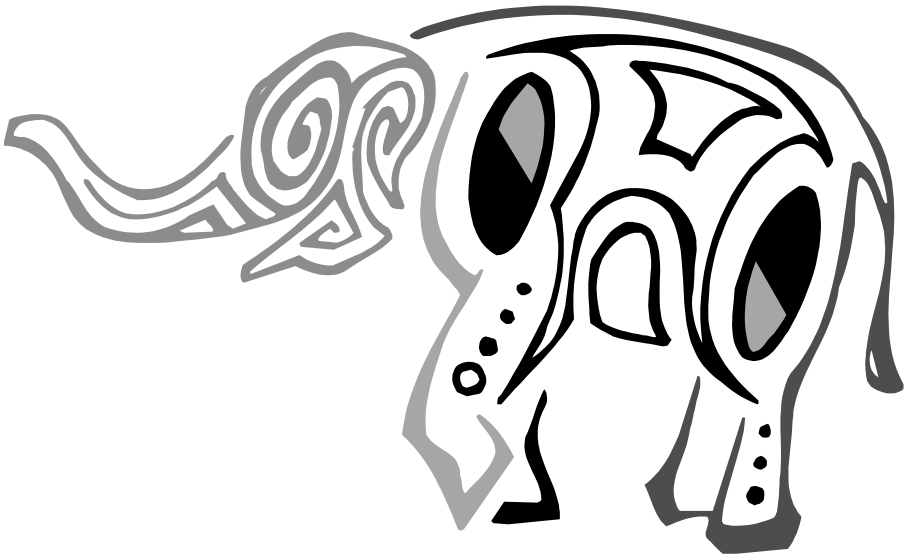
An aardvark named Avery,

And then couldn't wait to deplane them.





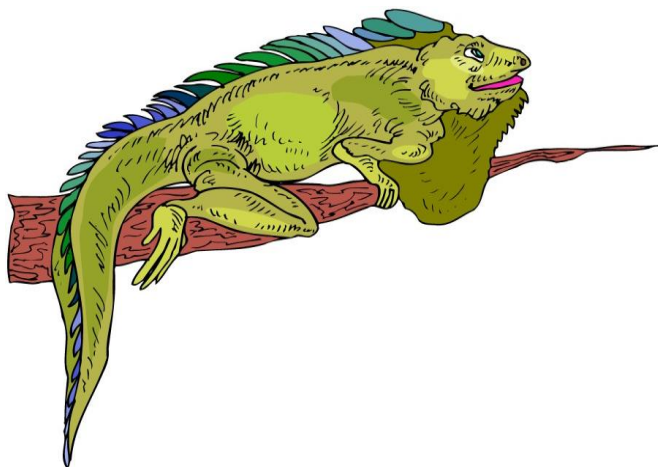
E is for **Elephant**

And he dances in a circle cause that's what he likes to do.

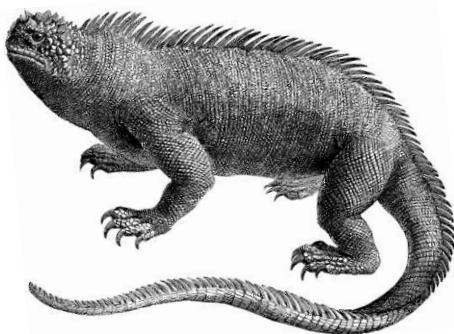


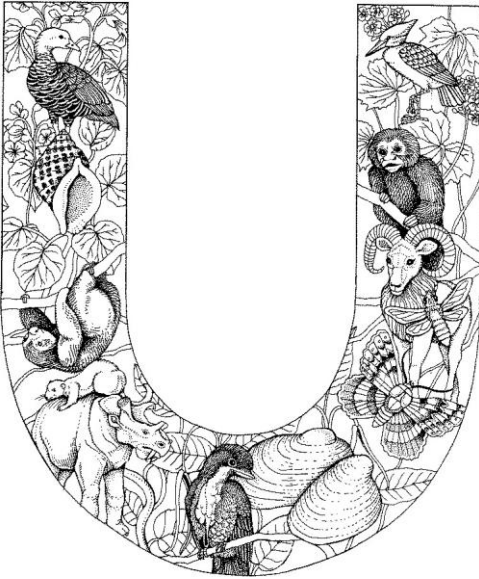


_is for Iguana
