

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

March 6, 2017

The Jewell County Commissioners met March 6, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners, Steve Greene, Mark Fleming and Keith Roe present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director, had a quote from Apple 1 Media Inc, Belleville for new signs with permit numbers as required for compliance. The quote is for 4 signs at 531.50 each to: Design, fabricate, 8'X4' maxmetal aluminum sign installed for a total of \$2126.00. Steve Greene moved and Keith Roe seconded approved the new signs to stay in compliance. Motion passed unanimously.

Travis reviewed quotes for skid steer loader with trade in of the wood chipper.

Motion passed unanimously.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed road and bridge maintenance. Joel discussed some streets in Montrose that someone wants closed.

Donald Jacobs discussed operations. The Commissioners reviewed a voucher with Donald Jacobs. They also discussed dispatching to fires and rescue calls. Don said tomorrow is the Statewide Tornado Drill.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:15 a.m. so the Commissioners could host the Multi County meeting in the Jewell County Courthouse meeting room. Commissioners and County Clerk's from Jewell, Mitchell, Osborne and Smith counties were present along with Anna Porter, Jewell County Appraiser; Heather Hartman, Mitchell County Community Development Director; Sherry Koster, County Sanitarian and Chad Hallack, KD94 & Z-96.3 radio stations. Anna Porter, Jewell County Appraiser, presented an overview of the property valuation process. Sherry Koster, County Sanitarian, provided a financial report. The group discussed legislative issues including the tax lid; IT position; e-waste recycling program and safety training programs. The next Multi County meeting will be at Mitchell County in June.
