Privacy Policy

Scope of this Privacy Policy

This “Privacy Policy” relates to the practices of the “Lakeland Police Foundation, Inc.” (hereafter “Foundation”) regarding sensitive information it may learn regarding persons/entities making donations to the Foundation by use of a credit or debit card. By “sensitive”, we mean information that identifies the donor while also revealing account information, perhaps home addresses, etc.

Information Collection and Use

The Foundation has contracted with an external company (hereafter “contractor”) who has established a process whereby donors can visit the Foundation website and electronically make donations by use of a credit or debit card such that the donation is electronically routed into the bank account of the Foundation. That contract memorializes that it is the intent of both the Foundation and the contractor that the contractor, not the Foundation, collect the sensitive information described above. Other than basic contact information of donors, it is not the intent of the Foundation to collect, e.g., credit card or debit card account information. If that information is somehow, inadvertently provided to the Foundation, it is the policy of the Foundation to immediately destroy those records, or portions of those records in its custody that contains that sensitive information.

Information Security

Our contractor works to protect the security of your sensitive information during transmission by using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) software, which encrypts information. Sensitive information is gathered on the secure computers of our contractor and stored in a secure data center. The number of employees involved in the management of the data center that have physical access to these computers is limited. Our contractor uses firewalls and other security technology, as well as the highest industry standard security practices to prevent their computers from being accessed by unauthorized persons. Our contractor also requires that any personally identifiable consumer information sent to them by donors is encrypted using SSL encryption. Our contractor currently adheres to the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards and undergoes annual third party reviews and quarterly network scans to ensure compliance. These standards were developed by the major credit card companies to mitigate potential attacks and compromises.
