Women's Program Director Carol La Vallee:

Carol LaVallee is the Women's Program Director at The Road to Hope, a recovery housing program for women with substance abuse issues. She has twenty-seven years of experience in recovery and has worked in the substance abuse field for twenty-one years.

Ms. LaVallee facilitated and assisted in evaluating program services for the Alcohol and Drug Boards of Mahoning and Cuyahoga Counties, and the Cuyahoga County Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Board. Over the years, Carol has facilitated and developed infrastructure for the Mahoning County Juvenile, Misdemeanor, and Felony Drug Courts. She was also a provider for a DUI Diversion Program and Criminal Justice Basic Education Program. In the past, Carol has been committed to serving the indigent through her volunteer work as President of the Mahoning County Homeless Coalition and providing service work at the Lorain County Jail.

Carol is dedicated to creating and maintaining an atmosphere that is conducive to recovery, individual healing and successful integration of the family and community. She enjoys helping women embrace the principles of recovery and watching them rebuild their lives.
