New! Organics Recycling Drop-off Programs at Spring Lake Park Recycling Center & Anoka County Compost Sites

Drop-off food scraps, non-recyclable paper products, coffee grounds and more at Spring Lake Park Recycling Center and Anoka County yard waste sites for FREE. When you participate in the organics recycling drop-off program, your food scraps and more will be turned into compost at a commercial compost facility. Compost is a valuable soil amendment that benefits all soil types, decreases the need for fertilizers and greatly improves moisture retention in sandy soil.

What are organics?

Organics are the biodegradable portion of trash that can be composted and makes up 25-35 percent of what we throw away. Organics include all food scraps, most non-recyclable and food-soiled paper and certified compostable products. Organics recycling is now considered another form of recycling and is an important component to help Anoka County achieve our goal of recycling 75% of our waste by 2030.

How is this program different?

This program is separate from the regular yard waste program for leaves, grass clippings and brush. Please do not mix yard waste with your organics. This program accepts more items than could be composted in a backyard compost bin, such as meat, dairy and bones. Commercial or industrial composting facilities reach high temperatures to break down these materials and kill pathogens.

What is accepted through the organics drop-off programs available through Spring Lake Park and Anoka County

- Dairy products
 - Eggs and egg shells
 - Coffee grounds and filters
 - Paper towels, napkins, tissues
 - Meat, poultry, fish including bones
 - Fruits, vegetables, peels, pits and rinds
 - BPI certified paper plates, cups and utensils
- Look for the logo (right) on the package.

- Mail, office and school papers
- Magazine and catalogs
- Newspapers and inserts
- Phone books
- Shredded paper in closed paper bags



Boxes:

- Cardboard
- Cereal and cracker boxes
- Shoe boxes, gift boxes and electronics boxes
- Toothpaste, medication and other toiletry boxes

Plastic

Bottles and jugs:

- Water, soda and juice bottles
- Milk and juice jugs
- Ketchup and salad dressing bottles
- Dishwashing liquid bottles and detergent jugs
- Shampoo, soap and lotion bottles



Cups and containers:

- Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups
- Disposal cups and bowls
- Margarine, cottage cheese and other containers
- Produce, deli and take out containers

Cartons

- Milk cartons
- Juice boxes
- Soup, broth and wine cartons



Metal

- Beverage and food cans



Glass

- Food and beverage bottles and jars

- Fluorescent bulbs
- Small and medium items (DVD and VCR players, stereos, speakers, record players, coffee makers, toasters, toaster ovens, keyboards, printers, vacuums, phones, small appliances, and video game consoles)
- Appliances
- Sealed lead acid, small household and rechargeable batteries
- TVs and monitors (all sizes) accepted
- Mattresses and box springs
- Carpet (no rubber back)
- Scrap metal (clean and all non-metal material removed)
- Hard drive shredding
