## ENTRY INFORMATION

*Entries are open to All-American dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program*

Separate fee for each dog each trial each day. When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class is considered the first entry. A Rally entry is NOT considered an additional entry for Obedience events, and an Obedience entry is not considered an additional entry for Rally events.

**Limited Entries:** In accordance with Chpt. 1, Sec. 27 of the AKC Regulations, each judge will be limited to a total of 8 hours of judging time per day. Entries will be processed in the order received and limits calculated for each judge. Obedience UDX and Rally RAE will be given priority.

**Faxed and Emailed Entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Trial Secretary at 318/397-0283 (call first). Entries may be emailed by sending a pdf file of the entry form(s) to the secretary at [gandypat@yahoo.com](mailto:gandypat@yahoo.com). Both the **front and back** of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will **NOT** be accepted. For faxed or emailed entries, payment must be made through Paypal. DKC **cannot** accept credit cards directly but can be used through Paypal. A convenience fee of \$1.00 per dog per entry will be added to the entry fees when using faxed or emailed entries. Contact the Trial Secretary for more information.

**Confirmations**, judging program, and correspondence will be sent via email if you provided an email address on your entry form. If you prefer paper copies, please advise the Trial Secretary.

**Open, Utility, and Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent** classes **must include jump heights on entry form**. Please put breed and date of trial on check. Entries must be on an Official AKC entry form or photocopy of the Official entry form **with the Agreement and rules on the reverse side**. Please print legibly!!

**Entry fee** will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

### Entry Information, Cont'd.

**Obedience Fees Collected by AKC.** Effective for events held on and after January 1, 2008, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all recording fees and Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. (AKC "Rules Applying to Dog Shows," Ch. 11, Sect. 2). These fees are included in the obedience entry fee.

**Rally Fees Collected by AKC.** At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 additional entry of same dog shall be required for the entry of each dog. (AKC "Rally Regulations", Chpt. 1, Sect. 3). This fee is included in your rally entry fee.

**Transfers (Move-Ups):** A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary *at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial*. Transfers between an "A" and "B" class at the same level are allowed – refer to Obedience Regulations, Chpt. 1, Section 16a and 16b.

**For Bitches in Season:** Refund of entry fees for entered bitches that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Trial Secretary before the start of the show. **A service fee of \$5.00 will be deducted from the refund.**

**Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$30.00 to the amount of each returned check.

**No entry fees will be refunded** if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

**Canadian exhibitors** must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

**Duplicate Entries:** There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

**No entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance, and will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

**Changes, additions or corrections** to entry forms **must be received in writing** prior to close of entries. E-mails are acceptable. ■

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The show site is available to exhibitors at **11:00 a.m.** on Friday and at **7:00 a.m.** on Saturday and Sunday. The building will close immediately following the match on Friday and Saturday nights. Dogs may **NOT** be left in the building. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately after the awarding of High In Trial on Sunday.

The crating area is set up under the supervision of the Building and Grounds Committee who may require rearrangement of exhibitor's set-ups where space is not properly utilized.

All dogs present **must be on leash** or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise pen.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Trial Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.** Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

D'Arbonne Kennel Club, Inc., the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Parking space is free and on a first-come, first-served basis. Extra spaces may not be saved. Parking is subject to control by Building and Grounds Committee. Vehicles or equipment may be required to be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. The area around the vehicles must be kept clean at all times.

All trophies/prizes must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. D'Arbonne Kennel Club, Inc. reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
