IEP/Evaluation Services Claiming Chart


In New Jersey, Health Evaluations are reimbursed at a single rate and should be documented by using the date and details of the students IEP meeting as the memorializing date that all associated health evaluations and/or assessments have been completed leading up to the creation of the IEP. The following four evaluation options are available in your EdPlan site for the SEMI program

This chart outlines IEP/Evaluation Services and whether they qualify as a claimable evaluation service under SEMI.

NON-BILLABLE SERVICE

Non-billable services can still be logged in EdPlan as long as they are selected from the "non-billable" events section



* If testing was waived, or team reviewed previous evaluations in creating the students new IEP, district must be able to locate previous evaluation in the event of an audit as well as have evidence in the IEP that the discussion took place using the previous materials (Present Levels, Relevant Data, Goals)
