## SECTION C HAY HAULING

**Entry Fee \$10.00 per team**

**Premiums:** 1<sup>st</sup>- \$75.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$50.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$25.00

**Rules:** (In addition to the General Rules)

1. **As always, your safety and the safety of your team members should be your first priority.**
2. **Teams must have 3 members; one member MUST be a licensed/insured driver.**
3. **Teams must use a current license and inspected pickup with a 8ft bed with a tailgate that is operable.**
4. **Hay will be loaded from a stack located a set distance from the pickup.**
5. **The hay stack will be 5 rows of 8, with 2 bales on top. Hay maybe loaded anyway with truck.**
6. **The engine must be shut off while loading and unloading hay or when all team members are out of truck.**
7. **The timer will start when the team exits the truck. The timer will stop when all team members are seated back in the truck after the hay is restacked correctly.**
8. **Only one person is to get out of the truck to open and shut the gate on the course. Door MUST be shut.**
9. **All 3 team members may get out of the truck to reload any hay that may have fallen off during transit.**
10. **There will be 10 second time penalties for the following:**

Stacking hay incorrectly at stack on ground	Doors left open
Hay lost during the course	Going off course
Broken Bales	Engine left running
Unsafe conduct	
11. **All hay bales that fall off the truck MUST be reloaded and returned to the stack where you started.**
12. **Load shall consist of 42 bales for boys and 38 bales for girls.**

**The fair board reserves the right to modify these rules on the night of the contest.**

**Premiums will be adjusted if LESS than 5 teams are entered.**
