DESCRIPTION: This is an earlier Ben Pearson Special. This is a structurally sound economical all-purpose bow. Had this been a high-end bow, I would have completely refinished the riser, but this bow wasn't worth it. It was cleaned-up with a few extra coats of tru-oil, but you can see the blemishes in the riser. The bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing; a few superficial stress lines, none of which extend into the working area of the limbs. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. Overall, this is a serviceable bow in excellent condition for its age. If you're more interested in a sound budget priced bow and not a show piece, this is a good choice. Since this bow does not have tip overlays, I recommend using only a Dacron string on it.
