On Tuesday 18th June the 'How Will They Hear' campaign are putting on a Refugee Ministry Roadshow.

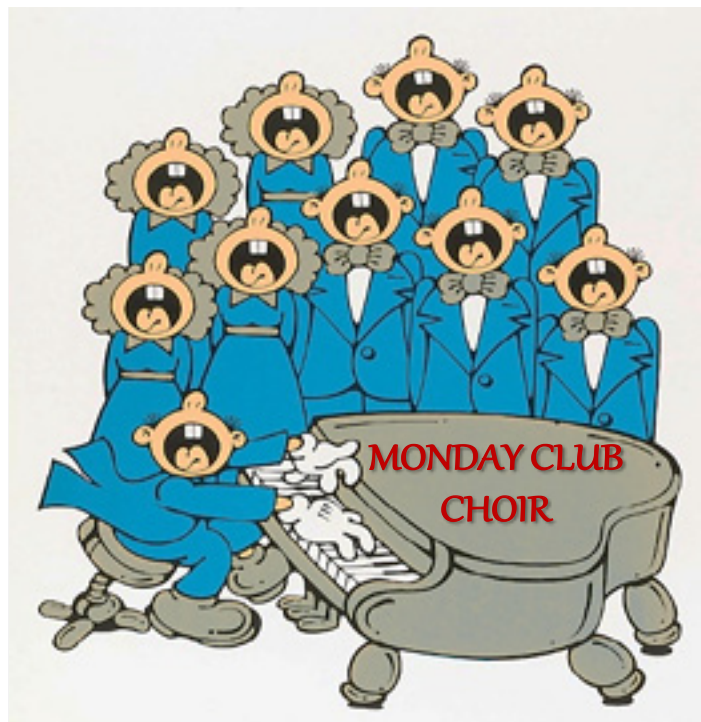
The event will take place at **The Oasis Church in Birmingham (B17 0DB)** from 7.30pm - 9.15pm.
