FRIENDLY REMINDER: Before planting season begins we'd like to remind residents not to plant crops in the road right-of-way. The right-of-way is most generally 33 feet from the center of any road or highway and any crops planted in the right-of-way would be violation of Minnesota Statute 160.2715. If you have questions, please contact us before you plant.

DUSTCOATING: Residents may sign-up for dust coating at the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 19th from 6:00pm – 8:00pm and on Saturday, April 22nd from 9:00 am – 12:00pm. If you prefer, you may mail a check payable to Marysville Township to the Town Hall; just call to confirm the cost and make sure your address and the number of feet to dustcoat are included on your check. Don't forget to mark the area with stakes. The cost will again be \$60 per 100 feet.

BURNING PERMITS: The most convenient way to get a burning permit is to go online to https://webapps8.dnr.state.mn.us/burning_permits/, create an account and activate the permit when you want to burn. Any restrictions are noted on the permit. There is an annual fee of \$5.00 and it's so convenient! ELECTIONS: Marysville Township held its election for 3year term for Supervisor on March 14th, 2017. Joe Hickman was elected with 23 votes.

BUILDING PERMITS: Contact the Wright County Planning & Zoning at 763-682-7338 before beginning your construction project to get any required permits.

ANNUAL MEETING/LEVY: The Annual Meeting was held immediately following the closing of the election polls on March 14th. This meeting was conducted by an appointed moderator, Fred Bonk, and the Board was there to provide information or listen to residents' concerns. The Townships financial status, road maintenance and operating needs for the future were topics of discussion. These issues can directly affect the levy amount for the following year.

These items can be taken to Wright County Compost Facility located at 404 County Road 37 NE, Buffalo (4 miles north of Buffalo on Hwy. 25 and 2 miles West on County Road 37). Recycle

RECYCLING: Recycling is picked up curbside starting at 7am. Everything can be missed together in the recycling bins provided by Mumford Sanitation. If you have questions about pick-up, please call Mumford Sanitation at 320-543-3601.

Recycling is taken to the McLeod County recycling center, where it is sorted and distributed. The more we recycle the better for the environment and it can even reduce your garbage bill! We do have additional bins available for recycling. The more you can recycle and can encourage your neighbor the better our program becomes.

The Wright County Compost Facility will accept hazardous materials, such as paint, varnish, oil, small batteries, etc. but you must call 763-682-7338 for an appointment. Thrift stores such as Love, Inc. (763-972-6547) in Delano, Wise Penny (763-682-4178) and Acts Thrift Store (763-682-1071) in Buffalo accept furniture and mattresses that are clean, stain free with no rips and some working electronics. Now & Again (763-682-1772) accepts furniture but no mattresses or electronics. *Call first just to be sure* of hours and whether or not they'll accept your donation. You may just be helping someone in need!

ROAD RESTRICTIONS: Road restrictions went into effect early this year on February 21st. For information, call the Wright County Highway Engineer at 763-682-7383 or visit the Wright County website home page at www.co.wright.mn.us where a map showing specific restrictions is available. This map is also posted in the window at the town hall.
