### What can our parents and seniors do?

Get into Social Media. Find new friends. Reconnect with old acquaintances. Write a book. No joke. Don't write intending to be a famous author, instead write to share your years of knowledge with others. How many youths today could be saved by learning the Lessons of Life from our Seniors? Invite your children, grandchildren, or nieces, or nephews, take you to Mass with them.

### Most importantly, Live! Don't just Hibernate waiting for God to call you home to Heaven.

If you're one of the many Priests and Pastors who read my Weekly Thought, seek new ways in which your Parish can become involved with our Forgotten Seniors. Make sure the Homebound, and those in Nursing Homes and Hospices have frequent visits from Priests and Deacons.
