

\*The DART program still does not have an H&I presentation due to lack of willingness.

\*We have established two new H&I meetings in our area, the new list of N.A. approved H&I presentations within our area is as follows:

-Pensacola Drug Court : Every other Thursday @ 730pm

\*\*We are currently trying to establish a new meeting at the UWF Pavilion; this meeting, if established would need members to attend a 2hr orientation. The time/days of the week of this meeting have yet to be established.
