## CHAMBER PRESIDENTS & CEOs TO ADDRESS BAR

Steve Clark, President and CEO of the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce and Perry Webb, President and CEO of the Springdale Chamber of Commerce will team up and lead what should be a very fun(ny) and informative program that highlights some of the current issues and opportunities that make Fayetteville and Springdale two of the greatest cities in the United States in which to live, work, and play.

Steve Clark is a former assistant dean at the University of Arkansas School of Law, and chief of staff to Gov. David Pryor. In 1979, at age 31, Clark became the nation's youngest attorney general. He argued eight cases in front of the United States Supreme Court, more than any other attorneys

general in Arkansas history, and is a past president of the National Association of Attorneys General.

Perry Webb is the former executive director of the Walnut Ridge and Forrest City Chambers of Commerce and in his current position as president and chief executive officer of the Springdale Chamber, Webb has worked in all facets of the business sector - from tourism, community and economic development to advertising, marketing and promotion. Perry received his Certified Chamber Executive designation in 2004 from the American Chamber of Commerce Executives. He also was appointed by Arkansas Governor Mike Huckabee

to serve on the Information Network of Arkansas' Board of Directors.
