



GUIDELINES FOR LENT 2018

For the Archdiocese of Seattle

Ash Wednesday, February 14th, 2018 and Good Friday, March 30th, 2018 are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence. Additionally,

- Fasting is to be observed by all eighteen years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their sixtieth birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.
- ♦ Abstinence is observed by all fourteen years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful should undertake these practices seriously and thoughtfully in a spirit of penance and of preparation for Baptism or of renewal of Baptism at Easter.

Obtaining Indulgence From GodThrough the Church

An indulgence is obtained through the Church who, by virtue of the power of binding and loosing granted her by Christ Jesus, intervenes in favor of individual Christians and opens for them the treasury of the merits of Christ and the saints to obtain from the Father of mercies the remission of the temporal punishments due for their sins. Thus the Church does not want simply to come to the aid of these Christians, but also to spur them to works of devotion, penance, and charity.

Since the faithful departed now being purified are also members of the same communion of saints, one way we can help them is to obtain indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments due for their sins may be remitted.

SOME THOUGHTS ON ASHES

Ash Wednesday isn't just the day after Mardi Gras as some may think...or Valentine's Day either really. It is for us the

opening of Lent and the traditional season of penance, reflection, prayer and grace. But more importantly it is the first step on the path that leads us to the celebration of Christ's Resurrection at Easter. 'Remember that you are dust, and onto dust you shall return," is certainly a very sobering thought regardless of the time of year as we take some time to reflect upon our own fragility and mortality and the need of God's redeeming mercy in our lives. While the ashes symbolize penance and contrition they are also a reminder that our God is gracious and merciful to those who call on Him with repentant hearts. In the first reading from the Mass on Ash Wednesday the Book of the Prophet Joel reflects these thoughts most

"Even now, says the LORD, return to me with your whole heart, with fasting, and weeping, and mourning; Rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the LORD, your God. For gracious and merciful is he, and return to the LORD, your God."
