## YOUTH AND JUNIOR ENTRIES ONLY

### Rules: (In addition to General Rules)

1. Dairy health rules apply, see Rules for Department 2.
2. All animals must be accompanied by an approved Health Certificate, which contains the dates of the last live virus vaccination or the dates of the last two killed virus vaccinations.
3. A completed Vet-Client Relationship form must be presented at check-in.
4. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required within 30 days of opening date of the fair.
5. It is strongly recommended that all cattle entering the show be currently immunized against IBR, PI3, and BVD. Rabies vaccination required. Proof of a current rabies vaccination must be presented at check-in. All drug and vaccine label directions should be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods.
