

Day 1: John 2:1-3

1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this passage? Why?
2. Why do you think Jesus' mother told him about the wine?
3. Spend time today thinking about some of the issues or problems in your life and whether or not you take them to Jesus first.

Day 2: John 2:4-5

1. What word or phrase stands out to you from these verses? Why?
2. Why does Jesus say his time has not yet come? What does he mean?
3. Spend time today thinking about God's timing in your life: Is there anything for which you are asking him that's not happening in your timing?

Day 3: John 2:6-8

1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this passage? Why?
2. How do you think the servants felt when Jesus told them what to do?
3. Spend time today thinking about what ways God may be asking you to step out in faith.

Day 4: John 2:9

1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this verse? Why?
2. Who knows what's going on here? Who doesn't?
3. Spend time today thinking about how God may be working in ways you don't realize.

Day 5: John 2:10

1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this verse? Why?
2. How does the wine Jesus makes compare to the other wine the guests are drinking?
3. Spend time today thinking about the ways Jesus satisfies us compared to the ways we try to seek satisfaction.

Day 6: John 2:11-12

1. What word or phrase stands out to you from these verses? Why?
2. Does it surprise you that turning water into wine is Jesus' first miracle?
3. Spend time today thinking about the ways God surprises us—and how you can be open to his surprises in your life.

Day 7: John 2:1-12

Read through the whole passage and write out the verse that spoke to you the most this week. Meditate on that verse today—and for an extra challenge, memorize it!
