

## Coast Guard Auxiliary Structure

The Auxiliary operating levels are broken down into four different operational levels: Flotilla, Division, District, and National. The simplest and basic level is the Flotilla. A Flotilla is the main response group for local communities and local waters. The Flotilla is comprised of fifteen qualified members who carry out the local missions. All Auxiliary members belong to a Flotilla. Divisions are a network of close proximity Flotillas. Divisions provide administrative, training, and support to Flotillas. District's provide administrative and supervisory support to Divisions, and promotes policies of both the District Commander and National Committee. The National staff functions with the Commandant to develop policies for the entire Coast Guard Auxiliary.
