




Religious Affiliation The 2017 American Family Survey





 Families are more mobile meaning congregations can no longer count on internal growth from the children they do have



Postmodern Religion


- A philosophical approach to religion that critically considers orthodox assumptions that may reflect power differences in society rather than universal truths.
- Postmodern religious systems of thought view realities as plural and subjective and dependent on the individual's worldview.
- Postmodern interpretations of religion acknowledge and value a multiplicity of diverse interpretations of truth, being and ways of seeing.
- There is a rejection of . . . global or dominant metanarratives in postmodern religion.
- A postmodern interpretation of religion emphasizes the key point that religious truth is highly individualistic, subjective and resides within the individual.

- Postmodernity
 - Postmoderns do not believe there is such a thing as universal truth; in other words, what is true for you may or may not be true for me

 - Postmoderns learn differently



- Postmodernity
 - Postmoderns do not trust institutional authority

- Church 3.0 emerging
 - Fluidity "open source" wisdom is not owned by organizations or hierarchies, constant mobility, creative disruption, less boundaries, membership not important
 - Diversity greater exposures to different religions, cultures, world views, ways of being
 - Relationships authenticity = authority, power of dialogue and exchange of ideas, self-disclosure expected and valued

- Church 3.0 emerging
 - Exploration space for questions and exploration, faith as lived experience, spiritual seekers seeking friends for the journey
 - Participative seeking real change, desire for tangible expressions of faith, shared leadership, high value on participation
 - Temporary lack of institutional structure, sometimes lack of organization, communities emerge and dissipate






Polity (Hierarchal vs. Congregational)






