THE 2015 COLLEGE FOOTBALL SEASON

The 2015 college football season is almost upon us and the interest nationally has never been greater. Even though the NFL is unquestionably the king as far as the size of the total fan base, college football is becoming more and more popular nationally. It has always been strong in the South and in the Midwest but the West Coast is becoming more and more vested in college football and in New York City and the rest of the Northeast, college football popularity is growing. It's possible that the Big Ten was on to something when they added Rutgers a couple of years ago. The interest in college football in the greater New York City area had been lagging compared to the rest of the country but television viewership has been going up over the past few years and even though they'll never have the high percentage of interest like an Atlanta, Columbus, Tampa or Dallas, the sheer number of potential viewers could be astronomical so having a school like Rutgers in a great conference like the Big Ten and getting high profile programs like Penn State, Ohio State, Michigan, Nebraska and Wisconsin coming into the area can only help grow the sport in the metropolitan New York City area.

Are we through with all of the conference expansion or is another wave just around the corner? After schools like Texas A&M, Nebraska, Missouri, Maryland, Rutgers, Utah, Pittsburgh, Colorado, Louisville, Syracuse, West Virginia and TCU switched leagues it seemed there wasn't much more that could be done but just this past Summer we heard whispers that the Big 12 was considering expansion and seeing a school like West Virginia all by itself, it wouldn't be surprising to see the Big 12 look closely at schools in the American Athletic Conference if they want to expand. Schools like Cincinnati, Memphis, UCF or South Florida would expand the Big 12's footprint into states they're not currently in and give West Virginia and little better geographical rival.

It's going to be interesting to see some of the traditional powers that have been down in recent years and what they will do in 2015. Is Butch Jones ready to get the Vols back in the hunt for the SEC Eastern Division title? If QB Josh Dobbs can continue to

improve, Tennessee might be in the thick of things when November rolls around. What about Texas? Charlie Strong seems to have weeded out a lot of the malcontents in Austin and if Tyrone Swoopes or Jerrod Heard can take the QB reigns and play at a high level, we should see a much improved Longhorn squad. In the Big Ten both Penn State and Michigan will be better but they both are a recruiting class or two away from dethroning Ohio State in the East Division. Christian Hackenberg was under constant pressure last year and James Franklin must find a dominant RB to take some of the pressure off, to allow him to be more successful. In Ann Arbor, Jim Harbaugh is definitely the right hire to get Michigan back competing for Big Ten and National titles. This guy knows what it takes to put a winning product on the field and he will get Michigan back by recruiting top notch blue chip players and getting them to sign with the Wolverines. College football is better when Tennessee, Texas, Penn State and Michigan are good. All four of those schools have 100,000 seat stadiums for a reason. They expect to be good and so do their loyal fans.

Last year, **THE BLITZ** had all four teams that were in the initial College Football Playoff in our preseason top 4. We had #1 Oregon; #2 Alabama; #3 Ohio St; #4 Florida St. Obviously, we felt good about that, even though Braxton Miller's season ending injury just before the opener made us nervous. This season, we have Ohio State, Alabama, USC and Oklahoma as our preseason Top 4. We have Oklahoma higher than any preseason publication but we have confidence in Bob Stoops' ability to get the Sooners back in national championship contention after stubbing their toe in 2014.

Who will be the surprise teams in 2015? We think that Michigan will be much better than they were last season. How about Colorado? It's been several years since the Buffaloes were good but we believe that Mike MacIntyre will get them to a bowl game. Finally, we forecast that Miami (FL) will be much improved in 2015 to take some of the heat off of Al Golden.

AROUND THE NATION

At the end of July, the Big Ten Conference announced that beginning with the 2016 season, not only would they begin playing 9 conference games, they would also require every member to schedule at least 1 non-conference game against a school from either the ACC, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC, Notre Dame or BYU. The Big Ten also announced that their members will only schedule non-conference games with schools in the FBS. That means no more padding their records by playing non-conference games against schools in the FCS. This decision will put more pressure on both the ACC and SEC. Those two conferences made the decision several months ago to continue to play just 8 conference games, even after adding schools and getting to 14 teams. Alabama's Nick Saban was the only SEC coach in favor of a 9 game conference schedule in that league. Historically, the SEC & ACC have played many more non-conference games vs IAA/FCS schools than the other major conferences. The Big 12 and Pac-12 have been playing 9 conference games for several years. Critics of the Big Ten's decision will point out that upsets like Appalachian State beating Michigan back in 2007 shows that FCS teams can compete on the field with FBS teams from time-to-time, but history also shows that more often than not, the FBS school will not only beat FCS schools but the scores will be lopsided. From 1978-2014 FBS schools defeated FCS schools 85% of the time and in recent years the percentage is even higher. Will other leagues follow the Big Ten's lead in eliminating games vs FCS schools? It's going to be interesting to see how all of this will ultimately play out.

Ohio State is the consensus #1 team in college football as the season opens up. Every major publication has Ohio State #1 as does the Associated Press. This is the 8th time that the Buckeyes have been the preseason #1 team in the AP poll (1958, 1962, 1969, 1970, 1980, 1998, 2006, 2015). Just an FYI, Ohio State has NEVER won the national championship in the previous seasons that they were the preseason #1.

2015 is the 146th anniversary of the first college football game when Rutgers beat Princeton 6-4 on November 6, 1869. College football has had many ups & downs but right now college football is as popular, nationally, as it's ever been.

WAS BEAR BRYANT EVER THE WINNINGEST COACH?

On November 28, 1981, Alabama defeated Auburn 28-17. That victory was Bryant's 315th meaning he had passed the great Amos Alonzo Stagg and all across the nation he was lauded as the winningest coach in the history of college football. Period, end-of-story, or was it? Well, during the Summer of 2011, 6 more wins were discovered on Pop Warner's ledger meaning he had won 319 games and he actually was the guy to catch, not Amos Alonzo Stagg. That being the case, that meant that Alabama's win over Penn State in 1982 was truly the game that put Bryant on top. Coach Bryant ended the 1982 season and his career with 323 wins. Period, end-of-story, or was it? Well in the Summer of 2013 the NCAA officially recognized Pop Warner as having 336 wins! In 2010 Pop Warner had 313 all-time victories. By the time 2013 rolled around, the NCAA had discovered an additional 23 wins for Pop Warner and that put him at 336 all-time wins. If that's the case, then technically, Bear Bryant was NEVER the winningest coach even though the NCAA said he was for many years. By the time the NCAA found that Pop Warner had 336 wins, Joe Paterno and Bobby Bowden has surpassed Bryant, Stagg and Warner. Below we show how the NCAA had changed the Won-Loss record of Pop Warner. I don't like to question the NCAA, but to think that Pop Warner was "truly" the head coach of Iowa State simultaneously when he was the head coach at Georgia, Cornell and Carlisle is questionable. If Iowa State has "credited" Pop Warner with wins, with out him being on the sidelines needs be researched further.

The neutral site for a college football game. Do you like them or do you prefer college football played on campus?

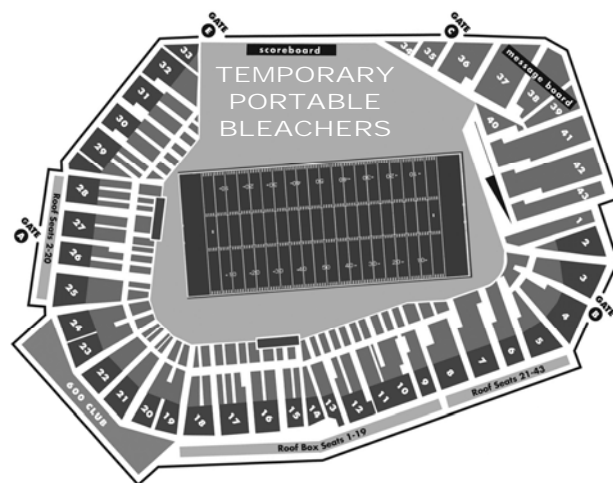
In recent seasons we have seen an increase in neutral sites hosting college football games. We have seen games played in Denver, Atlanta, Arlington, Chicago, New York, Houston and Seattle.

Back in the day, Notre Dame would barnstorm across the nation played before massive crowds at Soldier Field, old Yankee Stadium, Giants Stadium and Philadelphia's Municipal Stadium

Annual showdowns like Georgia-Florida in Jacksonville, Oklahoma-Texas in Dallas and Army-Navy in Philadelphia remain traditions that seemingly will endure forever, but as we have seen, traditions and college football are not guaranteed. We have seen annual neutral site games like Alabama-Auburn in Birmingham and Ole Miss-Mississippi State in Jackson eliminated because, the schools involved enlarged their on-campus stadiums and the desire to generate a larger sum of money with a home game.

We have always had some neutral site games played like those traditional games mentioned earlier or when the Kickoff Classic was played every season at Giants Stadium in East Rutherford, NJ but recently we have seen a real increase in the neutral sites hosting major college football.

While we discuss the neutral site games that have been played, perhaps three of the more anticipated neutral site games will be played in the next couple of seasons. Notre Dame and Boston College will play at Fenway Park this season while in 2016 Tennessee and Virginia Tech will meet at the Bristol Motor Speedway where it is expected to draw the largest crowd in college football history and LSU will travel up to Cheeshead territory to take on the Wisconsin Badgers at Lambeau Field in Green Bay.

On 26 occasions, a school has won their bowl game and ended up in the AP Rankings for the first and only time all season long. We researched just the seasons where the Final Poll was conducted AFTER the bowls had been played (1965; 1968-2014) and below are the only teams that were ranked just once the entire season, but it was in the final poll, after winning a bowl game. We list the season, the school, the conference they were a member of during that season (if any), their final AP Ranking, their win-loss record that season and finally, their result in the bowl they play that season.
