Rocky Ripple Town Council Updates/ Flood Protection Status - Special Meeting Scheduled for June 6th to View Options

Reiteration of Town Partnership with City and Butler for River Levee Repair

The Rocky Ripple Town Council wishes to state once again that it, as well as the majority of citizens of Rocky Ripple, agree that rebuilding and improvement of our river levee must be first and foremost pursued for the protection of our homes and residents. The best path forward for this crucial flood protection of our town is the continued partnership with Butler University and the City of Indianapolis to pursue the local floodwall options outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed by the RR Town Council, Butler University, and the City of Indianapolis to provide flood protection for Rocky Ripple on 14-Mar-2017. Thus, the town council does not support pursuing a lawsuit to stop the Westfield Alignment, as this could further hinder progress on flood protection for Rocky Ripple, as well as the surrounding areas. The signed MOU can be viewed in its entirety on the town website (www.rockyripple.com).

The MOU provides that the City of Indianapolis will provide \$10 million in assistance over the next 4 years toward the upgrade of the levee. What exactly will be done will be decided upon by the Town Council after consultation with town residents. In addition, the MOU specifies that Butler University will financially contribute to the project if a FEMA certified levee is pursued.

Potential options for flood protection that need to be decided upon in order to move forward with the MOU agreement include construction of a FEMA certified 100-year flood wall, construction of a flood wall that is not certified, or improvements to the current levee without construction of a wall. Special Meeting to Review Floodwall Renderings on June 6th

The town council has also been working with the city to have renderings drawn up of what Rocky Ripple will look like, depending on the option pursued. These renderings will be shared at a special meeting on Tuesday, June 6, 2017 at 7 pm at Meridian Street United Methodist Church, 5500 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis.

At this meeting residents and other interested parties can view the renderings and ask questions about the various options. City of Indianapolis representatives will be available to answer questions.

An assessment survey for residents and home owners will be provided at the meeting and delivered to each residence for completion. The survey asks for the resident to provide his/her viewpoints on what should be done for flood protection. The Town Council will then work to ensure that a completed survey is obtained from each residence/home owner in Rocky Ripple. The completed surveys will be utilized by the Town Council to determine which option will be pursued for flood protection.

Suggested changes to the bylaws must be submitted in writing for review 30 days in advance of the meeting to the secretary of the association. Don't forget....RRCA is not the same as the Town Council

The community association should not be confused with the Rocky Ripple Town Council, which is comprised of Rocky Ripple's elected representatives.

The Rocky Ripple Community Association is a separate organization whose mission is to provide social, cultural, recreational, and educational services to the Town of Rocky Ripple and its residents, and in so doing strengthen the bonds of civic unity and provide for the common welfare of all residents.

The RRCA has been in existence since November 12, 1948 when the Ladies Auxiliary of the Rocky Ripple Volunteer Fire Department was formed. Through the next four decades, the Ladies Auxiliary raised money to fund the volunteer fire department as well as provide social events for the residents of Rocky Ripple.

With the dissolution of the Volunteer Fire Department in 1989, the Ladies Auxiliary adopted new bylaws on February 6, 1990 and renamed the organization the Rocky Ripple Community Association. In March of 1998, the Community Association incorporated and became a Not For Profit organization in order to apply for grants, increase revenues and thus be able to provide additional support to our community.
