Holiday Giving Guidelines and Suggestions

Dolls: All ethnicities; for infants and children under age 2. Barbies, Bratz, My Scene, Doll accessories, clothing, cars, houses, Barbie/Bratz doll heads, rag dolls, Beanie baby dolls, Barney, Bob the Builder & Wendy, Hello Kitty, Madeline, Dora the Explorer

Books, Videos, Games: Harry Potter, Goosebumps, infant books, children books/CD's in Spanish, Tape/CD read alongs, Twister, Bratz, Dora the Explorer games, Yu-Gi-Uh cards, Finding Nemo, Barney, Barbie, Dr. Seuss. Any age appropriate items.

Educational Toys: Discovery, Leapfrog, Quantum Leap-Spelling, Math. Sesame Street baby discoveries, Fisher Price Brilliant Basics. Any age appropriate items
