

## **Monaco America Media Policy**

**General:** The Monaco America website was established in October 2009 for use by the members of Monaco America. Monaco America is an international club for the owners of all recreational vehicles that qualify for membership in the Family Motor Coach Association. This policy applies to all forms of electronic media, including but not limited to the website, Facebook, and RVillage. The purpose of this policy is to ensure a safe, functional, and enjoyable environment for Monaco America members.

**Points of Contact:** The webmaster point of contact is listed on the website [www. MonacoAmerica.com](http://www.MonacoAmerica.com). You may contact the webmaster using the Contact tab found on the navigation bar of each webpage. Facebook and RVillage have Monaco America moderators, and they may be contacted through those social media.

**Media Content:** The website is the property of Monaco America. The website content is protected by copyright; however, limited portions of the website may be reproduced for educational use if Monaco America is identified as the source. You may not link to any portion of the website other than the Home page. The content of Facebook and RVillage is posted by the users, and on the Monaco America pages the content must conform to this policy. If you find offensive content on the media, immediately notify the webmaster or moderators.

**Rules for Media Content:** All media content should be friendly and respectful. You may not attack other people or organizations or use foul language. Postings about religion, politics or subjects not directly concerned with RVing may be removed without warning. Individuals who violate this policy will be removed from our social media without warning. All postings of a commercial nature will be removed. Members may post notices of RV related items for sale that may be of interest to Monaco America members on Facebook and RVillage. Do not post commercial advertisements or items for sale in quantity. The social media moderators have the authority to remove content or members without warning.

**Website Privacy:** The website may contain personal information, including photos, about Monaco America members. If you do not wish to have your personal information on the website, contact the webmaster to have it removed. We respect your privacy and will not give or sell your personal information to anyone.

**Privacy on Social Media:** You must identify yourself on our social media with your first and last name. Anonymous postings have no place on our social media. Facebook and RVillage participation will be approved by the moderators. The content of these media services should be focused on subjects of interest to our membership. The social media moderators have the authority to approve or disapprove individuals joining our social media.

**Membership Roster and Directory:** Access to the Membership Roster and Membership Directory is controlled by password protection when possible. If a password is required, contact the webmaster using the Contact tab found on the navigation bar of each webpage.
