## Medical Services

VIP offers visual/medical/dental assistance to those offenders/probationers who are in need of such service to assist them in their rehabilitation.



## Emergency Funds

VIP provides funds to probation families for emergency needs which include, but are not limited to, food, clothing, temporary housing assistance, dental, optometric and medical services, furniture, vocational materials, and GED exam fees.

## Scholarships

VIP offers scholarships up to \$1,000 per student, per school year, to probationers who are in compliance with their probation conditions, have completed or are actively attempting to complete restitution payments, demonstrate ambition and drive to further their education or obtain vocational skills that promote self-sufficiency.
