- Six (6) mill real estate levy over 5 years
- Levy will generate \$985,216.00 annually

CURRENT

- Elected Positions
- Must be a registered voter
- No qualifications required for those running
- Must reside in Fostoria city limits
- Can be appointed if vacant
- Cannot increase pay wages during the term

PROPOSED

- Appointed by City Council
- Must be a registered voter
- Qualifications required by city council
- No residency requirement providing a wider net to find candidates
- Wages can be adjusted by council based on market changes



- Transition the Finance and Law Directors to appointed positions
- Allows city council to appoint qualified candidates who live outside of Fostoria
- Positions are accountable to City Council



- Establishing the role of City Manager
- Transitioning administrative duties of the mayor and safety service director into a new role
- Mayor's role will replace the president of City Council
- Allows city council to appoint qualified candidates who live outside of Fostoria
- Position is accountable to elected officials on City Council
