MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE GERVAIS CITY COUNCIL COUNTY OF MARION, STATE OF OREGON HELD AT GERVAIS CITY HALL AT 7:00 PM ON NOVEMBER 2, 2017

1. Call to Order

Council President Gregory called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

2. Roll Call:

4. Public Comment:

Public comment is limited to three (3) minutes per person with an optional two (2) minutes for Council questions and answers. If you wish to address Council please come forward to the podium and identify yourself for the record.

5. Consent Calendar:

- a. Approval of the minutes of the October 5, 2017 Regular Meeting
- b. Approval of bill list for September 28 October 24, 2017

Councilor Gregory made a motion to adopt the consent calendar as presented, seconded by Councilor Harvey. Motion is unanimously carried and so moved.

6. New Business

a. Approve Ordinance No. 17-002, An Ordinance Granting a Non-Exclusive Cable Television Franchise to Gervais Telephone Company D/B/A DataVision and Declaring an Emergency

Mayor Platt stated that this ordinance was read in its entirety at the last meeting and just

needed to be read by title and approved at this meeting. City Recorder Tim Rhyne asked if the ordinance needed to be read in its entirety at two meetings and Mayor Platt replied in the negative.

Councilor Gregory made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 17-002 to be read by title only, An Ordinance Granting a Non-Exclusive Cable Television Franchise to Gervais Telephone Company D/B/A DataVision and Declaring an Emergency. Seconded by John Harvey. All councilors indicated approval by saying "aye." Motion is unanimously carried and so moved.

b. Tree City USA Discussion

City Recorder Tim Rhyne briefly discussed the recent activity in town that related to requirements set by Tree City USA. Mayor Platt told Tim Rhyne that she will be giving a list of Tree City USA activities to City Manager Susie Marston that she, Mayor Platt, was involved with over at the schools. Councilor Gregory asked about the cost involved with the 184 man-hours listed in the Tree City USA tracking sheet. Tim Rhyne responded that Tree City USA assigns a dollar amount for per-hour labor but that he didn't know what that hourly amount was.

7. Staff Reports:

a. City Manager

Chief Spirup mentioned that Susie Marston intended to have a supplemental budget prepared for this meeting, but instead is planning to have it ready for the December 2017 meeting. The supplemental budget is for received Oregon marijuana tax in the amount of \$7700. There was a short discussion about marijuana tax. Tim Rhyne stated that he had nothing to report from Susie.

b. Police Department

Chief Spirup stated that the department recently participated in lockdown drills over at the schools. Our three police officers, not counting Chief Spirup, recently attended Marion County Child Abuse Protocol Training and are now trained to conduct child abuse investigations.

The Chief also mentioned that union labor negotiations will begin Monday, November 6th with Fraternal Order of Police. Lieutenant Chase and Chief Spirup will be negotiating for the city. Chief Spirup will bring information back to the council after negotiations.

Chief Spirup updated the council on staff progress and stated that Officer Palmer is proceeding with his training. One officer is still out on workers comp. The Chief talked to the council about the progress that has been made in the police department over the recent years. The Gervais Police Department is highly regarded to be one of the best small city departments in the State. One problem that is being faced is that there isn't always enough man power to keep up with all the work in Gervais. Part of this comes from being short-staffed at this time. Chief Spirup gave general comments about the department and its progress and challenges.

There was a short discussion with the Mayor and council about the police department training. Mayor Platt asked about the procedures behind active-shooter drills over at the school. The

council and Chief Spirup talked about the prioritization of duties in town. There was a short discussion about volunteer ordinance enforcement.

c. Public Works

Pat Claxton talked about storm damage to trees and personal property. John Robinson and Kyle Jentzsch both took recent tests. Kyle passed a wastewater treatment test and John passed a Level 2 Distribution test. Pat talked briefly about the training status of John and Kyle.

The recent storm work projects are done, in time for the fall/winter rain. The water plant painting project began, but now on hold until the weather is conducive to proper painting. A contractor is scheduled to begin work on the gate at public works by Monday. Pat updated the council on the 4th Street generator project. Mayor Platt asked if the splash pad worked this past summer and Pat answered in the affirmative. Pat also mentioned that discharge at the ponds began yesterday.

8. Business from the Mayor or Council

Mayor Platt reminded the council that Dollar General is having a ribbon-cutting ceremony on December 2nd at 8am. She also talked about the coat drive, toy collection and holiday activities in Gervais. There was a brief discussion about the date for distribution of the coats and toys. Mayor Platt also reminded the councilors about the upcoming annual COG dinner and encouraged interested councilors to submit their paperwork if they are planning to attend.

9. Adjourn

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30pm.



City Council Report for November 2017

This report covers the period of October 26 through November 29, 2017.

The following are samples of cases and activities worked by various officers during this reporting period:

- 1. Officer worked with Gervais High School on a number of truancy citations
- 2. We investigated a case of MIP alcohol at Gervais Middle School
- 3. Officers caught and transported two pit bull terriers to animal control after they chased a lady down the road. We could not identify the owners.
- 4. We conducted follow up investigation of a car that was stolen in Gervais and recovered in Salem.
- 5. An officer investigated a car break in where a child's Kindle tablet was stolen.
- 6. An officer was involved in a pursuit after he checked car for speeding on Douglas Avenue. When the officer stopped the car and walked up to the vehicle, the vehicle took off. The officer ended the pursuit when they entered a construction zone at the Woodburn city limits on Boones Ferry Rd. The officer found the vehicle abandoned a short time later. The vehicle had been stolen from Cheetah's in Salem. Salem Police recovered a stolen Subaru that was stolen in Woodburn at Cheetah's. It is believe the individuals our officer chased stole the Subaru in Woodburn, drove it to Cheetah's and then stole the car we chased back to Woodburn.
- 7. We investigated a situation where a student at Sam Brown Academy made threats related to firearms.
- 8. We conducted a welfare check of a grandmother whose grandson has a history of physical abuse and possible drug use.
- 9. Officers investigated a sex abuse and arrested the adult brother who abused his juvenile sister.

- 10. We issued a land lord a citation for 8 counts of junk and discarded vehicles under the municipal code after an extended period trying to get a property cleaned up.
- 11. We investigated 2 DHS cross reports related to possible use of meth in homes around children.
- 12. Officers conducted a welfare check of a family reportedly living in a garage without heat.
- 13. We were involved in two threat assessments at the school district related to students making threats about guns.
- 14. Officers with the assistance of the sheriff's office are investigating a suspicious death. A body was found at the Gervais public works ponds. The investigation continues.
- 15. An officer investigated a reported burglary at the old Fiber Fab facility. The circumstances are very similar to a burglary that occurred at the same location several months ago.
- 16. We investigated the aggravated theft of over 15,000 dollars of shower enclosures taken from the Fiber Fab lot.

General comments:

- 1. Officer Palmer is progressing through his training and has entered phase 2. We are hoping he will be ready for solo patrol by February.
- 2. Lt. Chase and I participated in a meeting with the school district to clarify the process for dealing with truancy citations.
- 3. We continue to be short staff with the ongoing absence of an officer related to a worker's comp case.
- 4. I have been participating in ongoing meetings related to a new law that will require police departments to collect data about stops. This has to do with concerns about racial profiling. I represent a small agency for the chief's association.
- 5. Lt. Chase will be participating in a committee that will be helping the county department of health identify service needs and plan services. This is a great opportunity for us to have input about issues we face in Gervais.

Gervais Public Works Monthly Report November 2017

It is the time of year that we move from weeds to leaves. They just seem to keep falling but we are getting a handle on them.

We have our new generator installed and operational on 4th Street. We had to remove the south wall in order to get the old one out and the new one in. We had quite a bit of work on our end getting the exhaust plumbed in and some of the monitoring equipment moved away from the parts that put out a considerable amount of heat. Creation electric was right there when we needed them and had it up and running in just a few days. The weather was a little sketchy, but everything went just as we planned.

For several years now, we have been concerned about the trees on the lot across the street from City Hall. The poplar trees all around town have some kind of disease and they are all dying off. Two or three times a year we have had to clean up limbs and branches that have fallen on the street and sidewalks. The most recent was a few weeks back that actually got hung up on the power lines knocking out the power to the lift station. The owner of the property, Mr. Kelly, had a tree service come in last week and they removed the troublesome trees.

Dollar General will be having their grand opening Saturday December 2nd at 8:00 AM and the Christmas ceremony will be happening later on that day as well. Hope all of you can find the time to come on down and show your support!!!
