



Book of the Month



We have a new emergency phone number for Fr. Ben! This is mainly for the Last Rites of the Church. The Last Rites are (ideally*) three Sacraments: the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, the Sacrament of Confession, and the Eucharist. These should be given if an individual is gravely ill or near death (this sacrament is also given to people before major surgery or other serious health issues that are not emergencies).

If you have an emergency and need to reach Fr. Ben, please call 717-323-2679.

*In certain situations, the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is the only one able to given.
