- Identify research question effectively (reference sources)
Conduct thorough preliminary research
Produce well understood, well stated contexts
 - Fieldwork, methods must be clear/relevant and explicitly justified
(remember to use and reference any relevant secondary sources of info)
(remember a risk assessment - to include risks to you - the student; the data; 3rd parties)
 - Effective critical analysis which is developed and complete
(explain how and why you have used specific analysis methods, what they show and how the results relate to your investigation ideas/hypotheses.)
 - Presentation must be logical + coherent - (contents, structure, incorporated figures/diagrams/photos, well headed sections, list of figures, appendices, bibliography)
 - Conclusions + evaluation - should be thorough effective complete
(detailed reflection + relate back to original ideas/hypotheses.)
