No firearms are allowed on Hill Country Trail Ride or any SALE properties; this being concealed or open carry!

Rules:

1. All Riders must be registered and wear trail ride badge at all times. No badge no entry into dance, breakfast, lunch and supper.
2. Pick up all trash and excess hay before you ride out. **DO NOT LEAVE FOR THE RIG MOVERS TO DO.**
3. We will ride out at set times set. If you are not ready, then you must meet us on the first break. This will be enforced.
4. Completely extinguish all camp fires.
5. Dogs must have rabies certificate and be on a leash.
6. If your rig is being moved by designated rig movers, please be sure it is ready to go. It is not the responsibility of the rig mover.
7. No drinking of alcoholic beverages on horseback and no public drunkenness. This will be enforced.
8. Please use proper riding etiquette. Don't ride where it's a danger to horses or riders. The Scouts and Marshall are on the ride for your safety.
9. No double riding.
10. Please tie a red ribbon on your horse's tail if the horse is a kicker.
11. If your behavior is unacceptable to the Trail Boss and/or other trail riders, you will be asked to leave the ride. No refund.
12. Good idea to have shoes on horses.
13. No dumping of sewage/waste water on any camp grounds.
14. No littering.
