SECTION 6-6-1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to create a system to allow the City to better remove snow from city streets.

SECTION 6-6-2: SNOW REMOVAL

No person who owns or has possession, custody, or control of any vehicle, trailer, boat, or other item, shall park or allow or permit another to park any such vehicle, trailer, boat, or other item upon any public street or in the City right-of-way when the removal of snow from the streets is apparent or imminent or when necessary determined by the City or County Sheriff.

SECTION 6-6-3: DEPOSITING IN GUTTER UNLAWFUL

Depositing in Gutter Unlawful: It shall be unlawful for any person removing snow from the sidewalk or driveway or other areas, to deposit or blow snow or any other material in the street, nor should any of these materials be deposited in the gutter so as to clog or prevent the free flow of water therein.

SECTION 6-6-4: PLACEMENT OF OBJECTS IN STREET DURING SNOW REMOVAL UNLAWFUL:

It shall be unlawful to place any object such as portable restrooms, dumpsters, building materials, construction debris, basketball standards, or any other objects that would impair snow removal vehicles on any paved surface when it is in the City right-of-way when the removal of snow from the streets is apparent or imminent or when necessary, as determined by the City or County Sheriff. Garbage cans are an exception to this rule, however, they should be placed directly against the curb or edge of the paved surface and removed from the right-of-way within ten hours after the garbage has been collected.

SECTION 6-6-5: EMERGENCY/CITY/OTHER VEHICLES EXEMPTED

There shall be an exception to the requirements of this Chapter for emergency vehicles, city maintenance vehicles, on-duty mail and parcel delivery vehicles or other necessary service vehicles if the vehicle is being used in the course of business.

SECTION 6-6-6: PENALTY

Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of this Chapter may be issued a warning and if the violation continues for 24 hours, may be charged with a class C misdemeanor. Any such vehicle, trailer, boat, or other item parked in violation of this Section shall be deemed a public nuisance and may be removed and towed away by or under the direction of the County Sheriff's Department.
