WEEK OF JUNE 18, 2017

Morning: Going to the People

[Thailand] A people group in Thailand is treated as outcasts because they are fleeing from oppression. They work long hours and make very little money. Although many migrant workers in Thailand have not heard the gospel, God is giving missionaries an opportunity to talk about Jesus. Recently, a team of high school and college students went to migrant worker villages to serve alongside missionaries who are supported through the Cooperative Program. The students went to a village to share the gospel, and five of the migrant women prayed to receive Jesus as their Savior. Pray for these women to boldly live for Jesus, and pray for more migrant workers to profess faith in Christ.

Evening: Partying for Jesus in Utah

[Utah] JEFF HURLBUT planted Morgan Grace Fellowship in Morgan County, Utah, the county with the highest per capita population of Mormons in the state. Last year missions teams from Mississippi and Kentucky helped Jeff host two daily "Party in the Park" events for children, which averaged 120 attendees. He says the children had a hard time understanding why people would come so far away just to play, sing and teach Bible stories to them. Jeff appreciates the Cooperative Program gifts of Southern Baptists and asks you to pray for his family's strength as they minister in Morgan County.
