## **PAYMENT & REGISTRATION**

Payment of \$150 must be made in full before your first game on the day of the tournament. Cash or checks are accepted. Make checks payable to the Class of 2020 CRHS. The tournament will start at 9AM.

## RULES

- 1. Good sportsmanship and a fun time are required for this tournament. We are playing to raise money for Grad Night and are here for good, clean fun and appreciate you for playing in our tournament today. Bad behavior will not be tolerated!
- 2. Home run bracelets are available before the tournament during registration at \$20 for men and \$15 for women. Teams can purchase as many as they want at those prices. The arm bands are for unlimited homeruns during games for men and women will get an extra base. Each team can only get 3 homeruns per game unless hit by men who have armbands. Only 3 homeruns by men without armbands is allowed, after that it is an out if you don't have an armband.
- The homerun derby will begin at noon and the cost is \$10/10 hits. Whomever hits the most wins. Men will hit first, followed by women. Women will hit from second base.
- 4. During the batting lineup, your batters must alternate male/female or female/male until all batters have batted. Your team can bat 12 if you want but you must have an equal number of males and females on your team. The lineup must be turned in to the official score keeper before each game.
- Pitches will be 10 feet high and a minimum of 5 feet. The strike zone will be behind home plate.
- 6. No metal spikes or cleats with metal exposed are not allowed.
- 7. The games will run for seven innings or 55 minutes, whichever comes first. There will be a 15-run mercy rule in effect after the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning, a 12-run mercy rule after the 4<sup>th</sup> inning, and a 10-run mercy rule after the 5<sup>th</sup> inning.
- 8. The umpires call will be final.
