Approval of Agenda: The agenda was reviewed.

Trustee Reports:

- Gavenda reported that Clinton County received a \$750,000 grant to be used for fire truck radios. Also, a chicken barbeque to support the Maple Rapids Fire Department is scheduled for July 29.
- Winsor to check on keys for Board of Review.

Treasurer's Report:

- The general ledger for the period 04/16/17 –06/15/17 was reviewed including checks #5834 5871.
- The total banking balance is \$146,656.89 with \$145,577.65 in the general fund and \$1,079.24 in tax checking. Total income for the period 04/16/17 –06/15/17 was \$26,428.77 while total expenses were \$27,877.56.
- Copies of summer newsletter were distributed.
- Winsor moved to accept the treasurer's report, supported by Gavenda. MPC.

Clerk's Report:

- Year to date budget was reviewed.
- George moved to hire John Anderson (Instone Data Solutions) to digitalize cemetery records at a cost not to exceed \$7000, supported by Gavenda. MPC.
- George moved to reallocate \$5500 in the budget from "Contingency" to "Cemetery Project", supported by Winsor. MPC
- An election is being held on August 8 to consider two millage proposals for Fulton Schools. Essex Township is consolidating with Fulton Township.
- George moved to accept the clerk's report, supported by Gavenda. MPC.

Supervisor's Report

- Winsor moved to use ballot proposal #1 in May 2018 election (Renew Extra-Voted Millage), supported by Gavenda. MPC.
- Doug Riley is monitoring the Maniez consent agreement and all is in compliance.
- Israel O'Boyle submitted a rezoning request to construct a driveway on wetland. No concerns from township.

- Mausoleum is in need of repair.
- A tree in violation of the cemetery ordinance has been removed from Sowle Cemetery.
- Plastic flowers will be removed from cemeteries in the winter if they are not secure and begin to blow around.
- Board of Review is to be held at same place as township meetings.
- Gavenda moved that board would adopt and embrace MTA's Principals of Governance, supported by Winsor. MPC.
- Township correspondence was reviewed.
