# Exalted Ruler's Message:

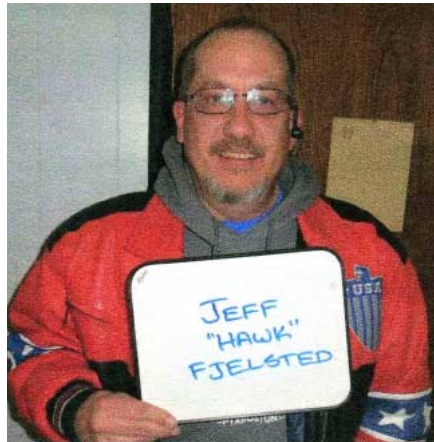

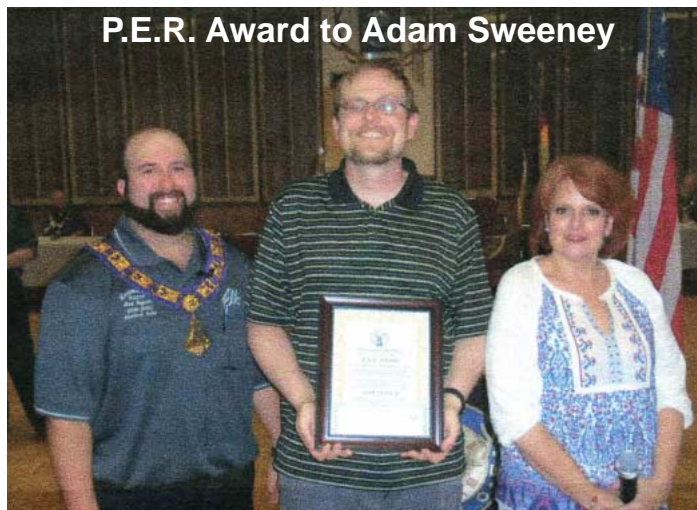

**WESTMINSTER ELKS LODGE #2227  
PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE  
04/09/19**

The current BY-LAWS and Rules of the Order for Westminster, CO, Lodge #2227 were approved by the Grand Lodge Committee on Judiciary in March, 2016.

Article V: Elective Officers and Duties; Section 4. OF THE SECRETARY; Page 9 states “For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive a compensation \$9,600 per annum, payable at \$800.00 per month. This compensation shall be reviewed annually in January by the Trustees with an appropriate By-Laws amendment prior to any change in compensation for the next Lodge year.”

Proposed By-Law change: For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive compensation of **\$15,000 per annum**, payable at **\$1,250 per month**.

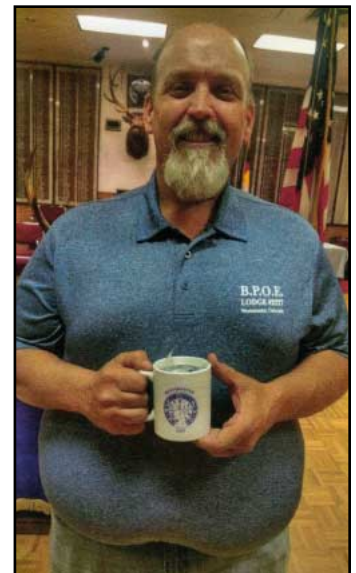
This will be published in the May edition of the Tales and the motion will be voted on Tuesday, May 21, 2019.
