## WESTMINSTER ELKS LODGE \#2227 PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE 04/09/19

The current BY-LAWS and Rules of the Order for Westminster, CO, Lodge \#2227 were approved by the Grand Lodge Committee on Judiciary in March, 2016.

Article V: Elective Officers and Duties; Section 4. OF THE SECRETARY; Page 9 states "For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive a compensation $\$ 9,600$ per annum, payable at $\$ 800.00$ per month. This compensation shall be reviewed annually in January by the Trustees with an appropriate By-Laws amendment prior to any change in compensation for the next Lodge year."

Proposed By-Law change: For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive compensation of $\$ \mathbf{1 5 , 0 0 0}$ per annum, payable at $\$ 1,250$ per month.

This will be published in the May edition of the Tales and the motion will be voted on Tuesday, May 21, 2019.
