Kathleen Corum, from Prescott Valley, AZ, will present the basics of the dog nose sports that are gaining popularity all over the US. Kathleen has experience with canine competitions of many types and levels including scent related events. She and her dogs have worked in the field for search and rescue and with wildlife research projects. She is an AKC Scent Work judge.

Building behavior chains through reward/reinforcement and back-chaining training methodology will be discussed. In this introductory class, Kathleen will work with you and your dog to introduce the Novice level odor (birch), for your dog to begin moving into the odor, and for you to recognize your dog's scenting behaviors. You and your dog will learn to work together to find these odors and you can earn titles at many levels from the AKC ScentWork Program or the NACSW's K9 Nose Work Program. There is an AKC ScentWork trial coming up in Prescott the first weekend of May, and NACSW's K9 Nose Work competitions are available in Central AZ.

You will be provided with basic equipment to start training at home, where you can include all your other dogs. One kit per person.

Each class is for one person, one dog. Please sign up for one class.

You will be able to participate in the afternoon AWTA Den Trial even if you are signed up for one of the training sessions.

Additional classes may be available for registration on the day if any vacancies remain, but pre-entry will help you get your first choice of class time.
