

SING – PLAY – SUMMER! Pastor Tara L. Eastman

Matthew 24:32 "Now learn the parable from the fig tree: when its branch has already become tender and puts forth its leaves, you know that summer is near.

As a child, my summers were filled with all these things, as well as my annual trip to church camp in Burton, Ohio. From the age of 6, summer camp allowed me the opportunity to hear about the love of God in Bible Study and devotions, learn praise songs *(Yes, "Pharaoh, Pharaoh "was one of those songs.)* around campfires and made friends with many people that without the opportunity of camp, I never would have met. Because of summer camp, I learned that God is part of all my days – and want to share the message that God is also a part of your summer ahead.

HOPE IN EL SALVADOR

El Salvador is one of the poorest, most dangerous countries in the world. Extreme poverty and violence often cause Central Americans to migrate to the US. When they find a job, they send money back to their family members to keep them from starving. But it is a dangerous process to cross the border, smugglers often extorting migrants out of hundreds of dollars to guarantee their safety. So, the Salvadoran Lutheran Church has launched a migrant ministry program which offers basic humanitarian assistance—food, medical care, and psychological attention—and attempts to address the economic desperation that causes the poor to seek to emigrate. Start-up funds are available to open small businesses; in one village there are now stores, a fish processing business, a beauty salon, bicycle repair, and a plantain farm. Where violent gangs are the issue, victims are turning to the Lutheran Church for help.

The ELCA supports the migrant ministry through the Accompanying Migrant Minors with Protection, Advocacy, Representation, and Opportunities (AMMPARO). Learn more at elca.org/ ammparo. Your mission support helps the Salvadoran Migrant Ministry! *Thank you!*



A church or a club?

Rev. Theodore Wedel, a former canon of the National Cathedral, once told a parable about congregational life. It began: "On a dangerous sea coast where shipwrecks often occur, there was a crude little lifesaving station. The building was just a hut, and there was only one boat, but the few devoted members kept a constant watch over the sea."


Some neighbors and people who'd been rescued began donating time and money, thinking the station needed better furnishings and equipment. As the station grew as a gathering place, members hired lifeboat crews to do the dirty work of saving lives. Those who disagreed with that approach broke away to form their own stations.

The parable concluded: "If you visit that sea coast today, you will find a number of exclusive clubs along that shore. Shipwrecks are frequent in those waters, but most of the people drown."
