Directions to Delafield Brewhaus:

From Milwaukee:

Just 35 minutes from Milwaukee! Take I-94 west and exit on Hwy 55 in Pewaukee. Stay on the north side service drive (Golf Road) heading west. At the third stop sign (Hwy. E) turn left; go under the expressway and take the first right turn (Hillside Drive). We're at the top of hill on the left.

From Madison:

Take I-94 east and exit on Hwy 83 in Delafield. Turn right, heading south. Turn left at the second traffic light (Hillside Drive) Go past the theater and Home Depot, we're at the top of the hill on the right.
