At the spring County Health Care Committee Meeting I asserted that many of you would like the County to offer us Delta Dental Insurance as an option. 4 points were articulated by the county: They consider this once every 3 years; nevertheless, they could re-consider it next year. (They considered it last year.) The County says it has continued to not offer it as an option because it is expensive for the consumer when considering how little coverage it provides. AARP offers a Delta Dental Insurance option which is more cost effective. Anyone can explore the latter with AARP.
