PREP INSTRUCTIONS

Surface: 5 3/4" x 8" round bulb ornament available from Lynne Andrews Folk Art, item #2012-98S

Paint: Americana


Avocado, Buttermilk, Burnt Umber, Country Red, Graphite, Lamp Black, Olive Green, Plantation Pine, Snow (Titanium) White, Spiced Pumpkin, Marigold

Brushes: Lynne Andrews #4, 8 floater (series 3020), #4, 8 stippler (series 3014) Good assortment of smaller mops 1/4" flat brush to paint check edge Brush to seal and basecoat

Misc. supplies: tracing paper, transfer paper, stylus, Rotring Tikky marker size 0.1 (available from Lynne Andrews Folk Art), DecoArt Glamour Dust- Crystal, black and white check craft ribbon (Michaels). Americana Sealer/ Finisher, Americana Multi Purpose sealer, hair dryer, small stick- on snowflake (Hobby Lobby), Tulip Puffy Dimensional Fabric Paint- White (Hobby Lobby or Michaels)

Preparation

- Basecoat the ornament in Butternilk. The edges will take more coats to cover dark edge.
- Transfer pattern.


