

As of today, Gloucester County now has 705 positive cases and 2,470 negative tests of COVID-19. Pitman is now at 16 confirmed cases ranging in age from 28 to 85 years old. The calls with the County and State representatives have now gone to a weekly basis as less and less truly new information is obtained and presented.

* Pitman Schools will remain closed until May 15, 2020 in adherence with the Governor's order.

*Our Lady Queen of Peace is open during the current crisis for curbside pickup for Pitman residents in need of food. Hours are 9:30 am- 10:30 am on Monday mornings and 6 pm - 7 pm on Wednesday evenings. Residents need only to show proof of residency to be eligible. Pickup is on the Highland Avenue corner of Pitman and Highland Avenues.

*The next County drive up testing site at Rowan College of South Jersey on Tanyard Road, Sewell will be offered on Thursday April 23 beginning at 10:00am. Residents 18 and older with symptoms of COVID-19 must call (856) 218-4142 starting Monday to be prescreened. Please have your insurance information available when you call. Once prescreened an appointment time will be scheduled.

*Gloucester County has established a program, "Gloucester County is Open for Business," that allows local business to input their name, location, website, business type, hour of operations and any take out, curbside pickup or delivery options that they have available for the public.
