LAKE AND BOAT RULES

- 1. No person shall be allowed in a boat without a USCG approved life preserver.
- 2. Pleasure riding in boats is prohibited.
- 3. No motors, except electric trolling motors, are to be used on the lake except when it is deemed necessary by the lake committee.
- 4. Swimming in the lakes is prohibited.
- 5. No jugs, trot lines, limb lines, bank lines, or nets allowed. Snagging and commercial fishing tactics are prohibited.
- 6. Each member shall register their catch on the log sheets provided at the main gate. Please include all catch and release numbers by denoting the amount of released fish with an "R" behind the number.
- 7. Dumping of fish from other lakes, or unused bait fish is expressly prohibited.
- 8. Only 2 poles per angler. A maximum of 4 hooks is also in effect.
- 9. Limits and size of catch allowed are posted at the gate bulletin board.

10. All rules and limits are subject to yearly change by the lake committee. These rules will be and must be complied with.

11. All guests fishing shall pay a 5.00 dollar per person fee. The fee shall be placed in an envelope marked with the member and guest names. The envelope shall then be deposited into the slot provided on the east end of the machine shed.

12. No guest fishing past midnight as all guests must be off the grounds by midnight.

13. Creel limits in effect as of August 2015:

- a. Bass: 1 fish over 18 inches
- b. Catfish: 4 fish any size
- c. Redear: 10 fish any size
- d. Bluegill: 20 fish any size
- e. Crappie: No restriction

14. The 15 dollar fine as stated in the Club bylaws will be applied on a per pole, per jug, per fish over, etc.... basis.

15. The lake committee and board of directors may spot check stringers and live wells at anytime.
