Our faith may be challenged and weak, but God is our author and finisher of our faith, (Hebrews 12:2). So, it does not matter what you think about your faith, God is the one who places faith in you. Yes, we all have a certain amount of hope and beliefs, but nothing can and will ever compare to the faith that God drops within your spirit. Whenever you have this assurance that nothing will move you, that is the faith that God has placed within you. That, my friends, is extraordinary faith!

When an extraordinary faith dwells within you, you no longer find yourself surviving when a situation causes you to fall to your knees. You are now living within the authority and power of Jesus' name that declares that your faith shall move mountains. You fall to your knees not in desperation, but by inspiration of the Holy Spirit to call unto the mighty name Jesus.

Jeremiah 33:3 says, "*Call unto Me, (God), and I will show you great and mighty things that you do not know.*" Your call, your voice, your cry unto God provokes Him to respond to your call. When you seek God with all your heart, mind, and soul, God will draw near to you.

I am reminded of the story of blind Bartimaeus, (Luck 18:35-43). Bartimaeus sat on the road side and when he heard that Jesus was passing by, Bartimaeus began to cry out. "*Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!*" The people that stood alongside the road were telling Bartimaeus to shut up! That didn't stop him. He cried even louder. "Jesus, Son is David, have mercy on me!"

Bartimaeus decided not to be conformed to what his environment wanted him to be. He was not going to keep silent. He decided that his condition was only an opportunity to position himself to call out to Jesus. He was not going to allow those around him to convince him that there was no hope for him. His extraordinary faith was moved by the people who told him to be silent.

When Satan tells you to shut up, that's when your faith becomes greater and your breakthrough is on its way. Satan knows that the second you cry out to Jesus, Satan is defeated.

The amazing revelation about this story wasn't Bartimaeus' cry or faith, although it may seem contradicting to what I am saying, it was when he identified by faith who he was speaking to. Remember he was blind. We walk by faith and not by sight. Jesus was not moved by the simple cry of Bartimaeus, but by what he cried out. When Bartimaeus cried out "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" He was actually revealing who Jesus truly was. When you declare who Jesus is, He is moved and the enemy trembles at the mention of His name.

I don't know what you might be going through, but what I do know for certain is that Jesus knows what your need are. Your faith can move the hand of God. Don't just settle on surviving, live in the power of Jesus' name.
