

Discipleship Path Coming to RFUMC

Join us on the NEXTSTEPS PATHWAY, a discipleship discovery program starting **April 8**th. NEXTSTEPS begins with **Class 101**: Learn about the vision of our church, core beliefs, how the church works, and church family introductions.
